

A Quick Guide to Creating a Hibbeler Engineering Mechanics Textbook with Customized Problem Set



Would you like to have more control over the problems you assign in your engineering mechanics course? With *Pearson Custom Hibbeler*, you have the freedom to create a unique set of problems to accompany R.C. Hibbeler's Engineering Mechanics: Statics, Dynamics, and combined Statics and Dynamics textbooks.

Here's how:

- (1) Start by going to the program page at:

- (2) On the program page, you'll find a **Build Your Book** link. Click to go to our online Book-Build site. Or you can click on this direct link: <http://pearson.gexinc.com/psmsv2/SSOLogin.jsp>
- (3) Here you'll be asked to log in with a username and password. If you already have access to our Instructor Resource Center, use your IRC name and password to "self-register." If you don't have an IRC name and password already, click on the appropriate link to go to the **IRC** site at: <http://www.pearsonhighered.com/educator/profile/ircHomeTab.page> and obtain them, and then come back to the Hibbeler log-in page to register.
- (4) Once you've entered your **Instructor Information** for contact and shipping purposes, you can move on and click on **Create New Custom Book**.
- (5) Set up your book and click on the appropriate radio button to choose Statics, Dynamics, or the combined text. In each case, you are selecting the "block" of core chapters from the book. These chapters include all the textual content plus fundamental problems.
- (6) When you are done, move on to **Step 1 – Gather Content**. Click on the folders of the chapters you wish to support with problems. Then click on the section folders to choose from Current Problems offered in the 12th Edition of the text, Additional Problems developed by the author, or any combination of the two. The system lets you click on the problem to preview it, the answer, and the worked solution. Color coding lets you immediately distinguish between easy, moderate, and difficult problems.
- (7) Continue until you have selected all the problems you need and click **Save**. Then complete your book by editing the sequence (Step 2), entering the course information to be printed on your custom cover (Step 3), and reviewing your book (Step 4).
- (8) When you have finished, click on **Generate ISBN**. Use this ISBN to place your bookstore order. Your custom books will be printed with the "block" of core chapters in front, and your custom problem set at the back. You will receive the desk copies of your custom text you require, and a customized Instructor Solutions Manual based on your problem set selections.

With *Pearson Custom Hibbeler*, you now can select problems that match your teaching approach, while keeping your statics, dynamics, or combined textbook fresh.
