

GUIDE TO BUILDING A BOOK ONLINE

1. GETTING STARTED

You can create your Pearson Custom Library: Philosophy and Religion custom text by filling out and faxing a completed Order Form or by using our online BookBuilding system. To access this system, go to www.pearsoncustom.com keyword search: **philosophy** and click on "Build Your Book." Set up an account and assign yourself a password in order to view and select content.
